Class Night Friday, May 20th in the Theater at HHS

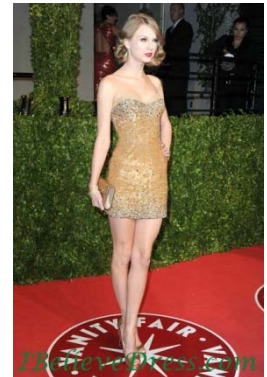
- Wear nice dress clothes for this event. Dress Slacks, button down, and Ties (Coats are not required, but certainly encouraged). Dresses or dress pants are recommended. Dresses should be appropriate, not revealing or short. You will be walking across the stage and down center steps – if your dress is short you will be revealing a **WHOLE LOT** to the audience! This event is not formal but style of dress must be better than a typical day at school. **No jeans or shorts.** Catoosa Dress Code applies.

- **Seniors will meet in the auxiliary gym by 5:45 pm for class night.** Parents and guests should try to be seated by 6:15 and we will begin at 6:30. This event is pretty crowded, so please be considerate – don't leave buffer seats.

Baccalaureate Sunday, May 20th at First Baptist Fort Oglethorpe Church

- Dress: Wear your graduation gown and all of your accessories as you would for graduation.
- Under your gown, wear dress clothes. No Jeans, shorts, tennis shoes etc.
- **Meet at the church at 1:30 wearing your gown (no cap).**
Students will meet downstairs in the fellowship hall
Parents and guests should be seated before 2pm, as this service will start at 2:00 pm.

Graduation Ceremony Saturday, May 26th at Heritage Jeff Sims Stadium

- Dress: Cap and Gown with dress clothes underneath. Gentlemen must wear a tie and dress shirt. Regular school dress code applies, but here are some additional restrictions to keep the event formal and dignified: **NO Jeans, Shorts, flip flops, tennis shoes, or casual sandals.** Ladies and Gentlemen should wear dress shoes. Ladies should avoid high heels since you will be walking across grass on the football field. Bring sunglasses!

- **Meet in the theater at 8:00 am with cap and gown on.** The processional will begin promptly at 9:00.
- Remind guests that noise makers, yelling and screaming, air horns, etc. are not an appropriate way to celebrate during graduation. With over 300 graduates, the extra loud celebrations in the stands prolongs the time it takes for everyone to walk the stage during graduation.
- You will pick up your official diploma **after** the graduation ceremony in the lobby.
- A reception will take place in the cafeteria following graduation. Please invite your family and guests.
