Heritage Middle School Cheerleading Tryout Information

It is time for cheerleading tryouts for Heritage Middle School! Parents should read this entire letter before giving their consent. APPLICATIONS ARE DUE NO LATER THAN Monday, April 6th. We will not take late applications.

Tryouts will be held at Heritage Middle School in the Auxiliary Gym on **April 17th.** Girls will be taught tryout material on **April 14th-16th**. <u>Attendance is NOT mandatory; however material will only be taught once.</u>

<u>Results will be posted on April 17th by 10pm on the HMS Cheerleading Webpage.</u> Score sheets are confidential and will not be open for review.

<u>Changes in the cheer program</u> The HMS cheerleading program will have one Spirit Squad this year. The Spirit Squad will cheer at Varsity Football games and Varsity Basketball home games. The competition squad will be selected from the Spirit squad and number of girls will be determined at tryouts.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. A candidate must currently be enrolled or planning to attend HMS during the upcoming 2015-2016 school year.
- 2. A candidate must meet No Pass/No Play guidelines.
- 3. Candidate must have a good attendance record. (Not missing more than 5 days per semester excused/unexcused).
- 4. Each candidate must obtain 2 teacher recommendations which will be averaged into the score.
- 5. A candidate must have satisfactory conduct report.
- 6. Each candidate must carry school insurance or present a signed waiver by parents stating they have adequate insurance.
- 7. Each candidate must turn in a Parental Permission Form to tryout.
- 8. Each candidate must turn in a **physical on the school form.** (This can be downloaded from the school website via this website: <u>http://heritagemiddleschoolathletics.weebly.com/athletic-forms.html</u>)
- 9. A candidate will not be permitted to participate in other school sports during the cheer season.

TRYOUTS

Tryouts are conducted as fairly as possible. Judges' rating on performance of the dance, cheer, tumbling, and jumps will be used to score the candidates. Judges' decisions are final, and the scores will <u>NOT</u> be open for inspection. The number of girls to be on the squad has not been pre-determined, and no member of the squad has been pre-selected. Please be advised, special consideration will not be given to those who have previously cheered at HMS or any other school. Even though experience may help your child to do a better job, it will not matter to the judges, since they will not know how many years of cheer, dance, music, baton, or gymnastics she has received. Keep in mind that if your child does not make the squad, she may try out again next year as long as she is still eligible.

Girls should wear tennis shoes, socks, and a comfortable shorts outfit to every practice for tryouts. Please pick your child up **promptly** after each session. All practices for tryouts are strictly <u>closed</u> sessions, this also includes the final judging. This means no one other than the girls that are trying out, judges, and coaches will be allowed to observe. No exceptions will be made for any reason.

- 1. The tryouts will consist of performing skills in front of a panel of judges.
- 2. All skills will be graded on the basis of the level of perfected execution. There are 5 categories that the judges will be scoring. The 5 categories are as follows:

Tumbling (20 points), cheer (25 points), dance routine (25 points), jumps (15 points), and Teacher recs & attendance (15 points).

- 3. The judges will be chosen on the basis of their expertise in cheerleading. They will be selected from outside of the HMS community if possible.
- 4. All cheers and routines necessary for tryouts will be taught at the clinic conducted by previous cheerleaders.

Requirements

A. Coaches' Scores During tryouts cheerleaders will be observed for the following qualities:

- 1. A positive attitude
- 2. Willingness to work hard
- 3. Leadership potential
- 4. Responsibility
- 5. Willingness to cooperate with others
- 6. Ability to listen well and follow instructions quickly

B. Judges' Scores During tryouts each cheerleader will be expected to perform the following:

- 1. Dance Routine
- 2. Group Cheer
- 3. Series of different jumps (double toe touch and pike)
- 4. Tumbling
- 5. General Qualities (Spirit, Facials, etc.)

The purpose of the HMS cheer program is to promote school pride, unity and to lead the student body in demonstrating spirit and support for the teams, coaches, and all athletes.

- <u>Always always be on time</u>!!!!!!!!! This is for arriving to practice as well as leaving.
- Attendance is mandatory.
- Tardiness will not be tolerated.
- Cheerleaders that do not follow instructions will sit out of games.
- Cheerleaders are responsible for the replacement cost of any property that is lost or damaged. (Uniforms)
- All personal matters must be dealt with outside of practice. Squad unity is a primary goal.

Required Cheer Practice Policy

All cheerleaders are expected to be at **<u>EVERY</u>** practice. With **prior arrangements**, up to two practices may be missed.

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The cost of trying out for the HMS Cheer Squads is \$10 this helps us to cover the cost of judges' fees and other materials needed. The check must be made out to HMS. Please be sure your check has a phone number on it, this is a school policy. This payment is due by March 20th along with the rest of the tryout forms.

Parents must assume all costs for their daughter. Payments will be due at the beginning of each month on the 5th starting in May. Every account must be paid off by October 5th. Sometimes these expenses are due without much notice. They cannot be charged or paid in installments. Failure to make the required purchases would result in dismissal from the squad. Additionally, if for any reason the squad is dissolved, your child quits, or is dismissed from the squad, there will be no way to recover the money spent.

Fundraisers will be made available to help with expenses throughout the year. If you feel that you may not be able to meet these expenses, then please do not let your child try out.

Important Dates

IF your child makes the cheer squad for the 2015-2016 season, they MUST be at all of the following events:

Tuesdays beginning April 21st @ RAH from 6:00-8:00- All <u>competition</u> cheerleaders must attend RAH *every* Tuesday night. Spirit Squad cheerleaders will practice from 6:00-7:00 and competition only from 7:00-8:00. *However, for the month of APRIL ONLY everyone will attend from 6:00-8:00*. These practices will start April **This is not an option, but a mandatory practice.** These practices should be treated just as our school practices. Attendance, punctuality, etc. are all required. Cost is around \$60.

Monday, April 20th - 6:00

Parent meeting in the HMS media center (Parent & Cheerleader MUST be present)

\$150 is due at this meeting. This is for uniform rental (3 uniforms total). The first fundraiser will start on this night as well. This is a "Sell Your Spirit" T-shirt where the girls can get family and friends (not businesses) to sponsor them at \$25 for a megaphone on the back of their personal t-shirt. The first \$25 goes to the cost of the shirt and the rest of the money raised will go into your cheerleader's personal account to help pay for camp, clothes, etc. More information at this meeting.

You will also get information about the **Football Program ads**. The ads and money will be due by June 17th. More information will be given out at the meeting.

<u>June $2^{nd}-3^{rd}$ </u> we will have a band dance/sideline cheer clinic where we will team up with the HHS Spirit Squad and learn the band dances and sideline cheers for the season. This is a mandatory clinic and there will also be team building activities built in. Times and more details will be given soon.

Monday June 8th and Tuesday June 9th Competition Choreography at HMS. Friday we will practice from

Summer Vacations:

If you have not already planned vacations, please try to do so **June 28th-July 4th**. It's hard to work on our routine when someone else is absent each week. Obviously, you have to do what's best for your family, but if you could go one of these weeks that would be great! Girls are only allowed to miss 2 summer practices, after that, there are consequences. (Running, conditioning, benching.)

Remember each month on the 5th there will be a \$200 payment due to pay towards your daughter's balance. Last year's dues were about \$1000 for each participant. We will offer various fundraisers throughout the summer to help pay this balance. If you need extra fundraisers, please see one of us and we will get one for you. I encourage everyone to participate in the individual fundraisers offered so that you are not paying too much out of pocket.
