

Open House/Curriculum Night at Heritage Middle School September 17, 2018 6:15 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Curriculum Night at Heritage Middle is a special event you won't want to miss! Our goal for this evening is to provide you with an opportunity to meet and greet your child's teachers, follow his/her schedule for the evening, and hear a brief overview of what the classes will look like throughout the year. We hope you will join us for this informational evening!

The first part of HMS Curriculum Night will take place in our gym. During this session, you will hear a welcome from Mr. Chris Lusk to be followed by a brief explanation of our 1st and 7th block classes. After the opening session, you will travel to your child's homeroom class (There will be homeroom lists posted on the wall at both entrances if you need to know your child's homeroom teacher). When you get to your child's homeroom class, you will receive a copy of his/her class schedule to follow the rest of the evening.

\star 6:30 – 8:00 p.m.

Follow your child's schedule to get a "snapshot" of a day in the life of your middle schooler. You will follow your student's 7-period day in the order of his/her daily classes. Please see the schedule below.

You will meet in each teacher's room for approximately 15 minutes. Each teacher will

give a general overview of the Georgia Standards of Excellence for their class, instructional strategies planned, and types of assessments students can expect in each class. In addition, each teacher may discuss their classroom daily routine, show examples of student work, or have you participate in a learning activity.
