

Length

- Inch (in) – width of your thumb
- Foot (ft) – distance from elbow to wrist
- Yard (yd) – width of a door (yard stick)
- Mile (mi) – 18 football fields together

Weight

- Ounce (oz) – slice of bread
- Pound (lb) – loaf of bread
- Ton (T) – a small car

Capacity – (how much liquid it will hold)

- Fluid ounce (fl oz) – spoonful
- Cup (c) – glass of juice
- Pint (pt) – small bottle of salad dressing
- Quart (qt) – small container of paint
- Gallon (gal) – large container of milk

Ex. A table is about 4 _____ long. (Answer: feet – ft)

Ex. A ceiling is about 3 _____ high. (Answer: yards – yd)

Ex. A female elephant can weigh up to 4 _____. (Answer: tons – T)

Ex. A remote control weighs about 3 _____. (Answer: ounces – oz)

Ex. A bath tub holds about 50 _____ of water. (Answer: gallons – gal)
