You cannot use an example but once.</i></li> <li>4. <i>Did you give enough details for each example that if I've never read the book before, I'd “see” and understand your points?</i></li> <li>5. <i>Did you explain how the example SHOWED the trait that you've said Buck had?</i></li> <li>6. <i>Did you tell which chapter the details came from for EACH detail?</i></li> </ol>
