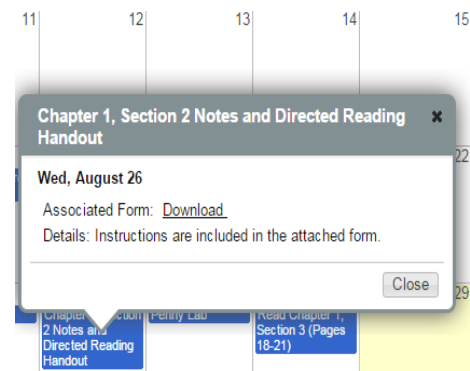

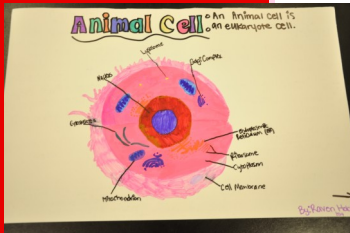

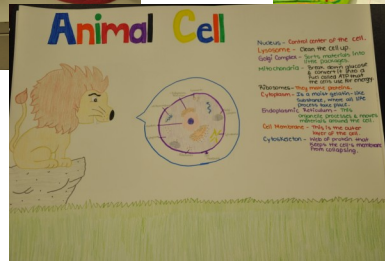
Life Science: Cells Success!
