## **Final Exams**


We interviewed our principal to see how the exams will work; he said the exams will last from Wednesday, December 21 through Thursday, December 22. Next, Mr. Phillips said you can get exempt from exams through grades and attendance. You at least have to get an A with no more than three absences, a B with no more than two absences, and a C with no more than one absence to be exempt. If you have any D's or F's, you have to come. Even if you have a passing grade, you still have to take exams if you have more than three absences. Mr. Phillips said 300 to 500 students will be exempt a year.

Next, he said there are four exams in all, two a day. The first exam lasts from 8:40 to 9:55, and the second exam lasts from 10:30 to 11:45. After testing if students do not go home, they will eat lunch around noon. After that they will be assigned to a connection teacher. There are exams for gateway and ISS students, but they have to go back to gateway or ISS after all testing periods are over. Students can only use the chromebooks if the teachers say so. During final exams, students will only be able to talk if the teacher lets them.

Then, the back spot pushes her butt up and grabs her ankles as the bases are lifting the flyer's feet up to their shoulders. Then, the cheerleaders will go from a prep to an extension. That is when the bases extend their arms up above their heads as the backspot pushes her ankles up. These are some of the stunts that we do here at Lakeview. Also, the cheerleaders do a lot of tumbling. Some examples of tumbling are:

round-offs, cartwheels, standing back handsprings,  
round-off-backhandspring, round-off-back  
tuck, and round-off-backhandspring-back tuck.

### The Gatlinburg Fire

Are you going to Gatlinburg, TN for Christmas? If you are, then you should check and make sure that you still have a vacation home to go to because of the Gatlinburg fire that happened on November 29, 2016. The forest fires in Gatlinburg were caused by arson, which is when people do acts of criminal activity.

Forest fires always can start two different ways: naturally caused or human caused. Natural fires are generally started by lightning. On the other hand, human-caused fires can be due to any number of reasons. The Gatlinburg fire started by two teenagers. One was 17 and the other was 15. They were throwing matches on the ground around the trail they were on to find their way back.

The Gatlinburg forest fire killed 14 people; it also damaged or destroyed 2,400 homes and businesses. More than 190 people have been treated for fire-related injuries and illnesses. The Gatlinburg fires caused \$500,000,000 in damage.

The flames swept through Gatlinburg, about 10 miles up the mountain from Sevierville TN, in about 15 minutes, and winds fanned at

speeds that approached 90 mph. Heavy rains a few days later helped the firefighters extinguish much of the fire.

Dolly Parton pledged that she would give \$1000 to each family that lost everything in the fire for six months. Dolly Parton also started a donation that has raised about \$9,000,000 so far. Also, The Red Cross and The National Guard are helping with the relief efforts.
