Title I Parent and Family Engagement

LMS receives Title I funds to assist students in meeting state achievement standards. As a Title I school, we must meet federal regulations related to teacher qualifications as defined in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). These regulations allow you to learn more about your child's teachers' training and credentials. At any time you may ask:

- Whether the teacher met state qualifications and certification requirements for the grade level and subject he/she is teaching;
- Whether the teacher received an emergency or conditional certificate through which state qualifications were waived, and;
- What undergraduate or graduate degrees the teacher holds, including graduate certificates and additional degrees, major(s), or area(s) of concentration.
- You may also ask whether your child received help from a paraprofessional and information about the paraprofessionals' qualifications.

Rest assured that our staff is committed to helping your child reach his or her maximum academic potential. That commitment includes making sure that all our teachers and paraprofessionals are highly skilled and delivering quality instruction to your child.

Positive Behavioral Intervention Systems (PBIS)

PBIS is part of a state-wide effort to recognize and reinforce positive behavior choices. By making smart choices with behavior at school, students can receive numerous rewards. Students can earn Warrior Ones, which can be used at the Warrior Way Store, the Warrior Way Café, and the Warrior Way Game Room. Students can also win monthly rewards and various prizes. Behavior Expectation posters will be posted throughout the school to remind students of school-wide expectations. We encourage all students to "Set High Expectations and Make Smart Choices" each day at Lakeview Middle School.
