How do I participate?

Adopt as many ducks as you would like by going to our website www.ciscatoosa.com to order. Ducks start at \$10 but packages are available. With your donation, you will be assigned a special "Lucky Duck" number and entered into one of several qualifying races for a chance to compete in the Grand Derby. For example, if you purchase 1 duck then you will have one duck entered into a qualifying race. If you purchase 5 ducks, you will have 5 ducks entered into a qualifying race with your "Lucky Duck" number. When you order through our website, you will be assigned a special Lucky Duck number.
