Identity theft is when someone wrongfully acquires and uses a consumer's personal identification, credit, or account information.

- What do thieves do once they have your information?

- Write fraudulent checks,
- Make large purchases all in the consumer's name.

How do thieves acquire your information?

The most common are as follows:

- Steal wallet
- Steal mail
- Dumpster/ trash diving
- Internet
