

RINGGOLD HIGH SCHOOL JUNIOR REGISTRATION GUIDE FOR THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

On-line registration is **Feb. 20–Mar.2**. Students will not be able to make on-line changes after this date. The RHS will host **Parent Night in the RHS Theater at 7:00pm February 22nd** for a high school presentation and help with registration.

Students take a total of 8 classes each year. Below are required courses; students must select one from each category. Choose remaining classes from the Electives Chart (**students are expected to complete a pathway**). It is important that you enter each number correctly when you request your classes.

Step 1: Login your Student or Parent Portal (can be found at <http://rhs.catoosa.k12.ga.us>). **If you have never used** Student Portal, your username is your student number (lunch number), and the password is your first initial, last initial, birth month, birth day, birth year (mmddyyyy). Example John Doe May 1, 1996 would have the password “jd05011996.” If you have problems with username/password, contact your school counselor.

Step 2: From the main portal page, click on the “Course Registration 18-19 option on the left of the screen.

Step 3: Request courses. Click the “**course search**” link. Courses can be searched by name or number. Both are available on this sheet and the RHS website. Enter a course that you want and click the “**go**” button. To add the course, click on the “**request**” button. To drop a course, click on the requested course then click on “**drop this request.**” Choose 8 courses. Do not request “Alternates.” They will be deleted.

Step 4: If you follow the steps correctly, the screen will read 16 out of 16 Requested Units. You are done. RHS Administration reserves the right to make changes to course requests that are necessary to meet graduation requirements.

Contact your school counselor before **May 23, 2018**. * If you select an **honors or AP class**, the deadline for dropping it is **May 23, 2018**. Any AP class is a college level class and is taught and graded as such. **After May 23**, teacher schedules will be set, and we cannot make changes. Students who plan to attend a **four year college** are encouraged to take honors classes and AP classes. Contact an RHS school counselor before **May 23, 2018**.
