Coordinate Algebra EOCT is 20% of your semester grade.

Your semester grade is 40% 1^{st} 9-weeks, 40% 2^{nd} 9-weeks, and 20% final exam. 90-100 is an A, 80-89 is a B, 79-74 is a C, 70-73 is a D, <70 is F

Make-up work:
