

RINGGOLD HIGH SCHOOL JUNIOR REGISTRATION GUIDE FOR THE 2015-16 SCHOOL YEAR

The on-line registration window is **Feb. 9–Feb. 19**. Students will not be able to make on-line changes after this date. On **Parent Night, March 19, 2015 from 3:30-7:00pm**, parents and students will be able to review course requests.

Students take a total of 8 classes each year. You must have 4 classes in each core area to graduate. You will request these from the Core Classes below. The remaining 4 classes should be chosen from the Electives Chart (students are expected to complete a pathway). It is important that you enter each number correctly when you request your classes.

Step 1: Login your Student or Parent Portal (can be found at <http://rhs.catoosa.k12.ga.us>). For Student Portal, your username will be you student number (lunch number), and the password will be your first initial, last initial, birth month, birth day, birth year (mmddyyyy). Example John Doe May 1, 1996 would have the password “jd05011996.” You may have changed your password in the past. If you have problems with username/password, contact your school counselor.

Step 2: From the main portal page, click on the “Course Registration 15-16” option on the left of the screen.

Step 3: Request courses. Click the “**course search**” link. Courses can be searched by name of number. Both are available on this sheet and the school website. Enter a course that you want and click the “**go**” button. To add the course, click on the “**request**” button. To drop a course, click on the requested course then click on “**drop this request.**”

Choose only 8 courses.

RHS Administration and School Counselors reserve the right to make changes to course requests that are necessary to meet graduation requirements or are in the best interest of individual student success.

The deadline for changing course requests is **May 15, 2015**. **After May 15**, teacher schedules will be set, and we cannot make changes. Contact your school counselor before **May 15, 2015**. If you select an **honors or AP class**, the deadline for dropping it is **May 15, 2015**. Any AP class is a college level class and is taught and graded as such. **After May 15**, teacher schedules will be set, and we cannot make changes. Students who plan to attend a **four year college** are encouraged to take honors classes and AP classes. Contact your school counselor before **May 15, 2015**.

***HOPE Rigor requirements:** Over 4 years of high school, students in the Class of 2017 must pass 4 classes from the Rigor Classes list (found on the RHS website) in order to be eligible for HOPE Scholarships or Zell Miller Scholarships.
