District Goal:

- To improve the percentage of students scoring proficient (levels 3,4) in grades 3- 8.
- To improve the percentage of students graduating from high school.

School Goals:

Ringgold Primary School will increase Reading benchmark scores at or above grade level by 20% between fall and spring tests in order to prepare students for the next grade level.

First Grade will focus on the following areas in ELA
