GOALS FOR STUDENT LEARNING

District Goal:

- To improve the percentage of students scoring proficient (levels 3,4) in grades 3-8.
- To improve the percentage of students graduating from high school.

School Goals:

Ringgold Primary School will increase Reading benchmark scores at or above grade level by 20% between fall and spring tests in order to prepare students for the next grade level.

Second Grade will focus on the following areas in ELA

• Increase oral reading fluency

Ringgold Primary School will increase Math benchmark scores at or above grade level by 20% between fall and spring tests in order to prepare students for the next grade level.

Second Grade will focus on the following areas in Math.

• Increase math fact fluency

Ringgold Primary School attendance goal:

The percent of students in K-2 missing 6 days or more will decrease by 3% by May 24, 2019
