COUNSELOR'S CORNER.

Hello my name is Ann Elrod and I am so excited to start another school year here at Ringgold Primary School! As your School Counselor, I am here to help ALL students be successful socially, emotionally, and behaviorally so they may access their education without barriers.

-Here is what I do at our school:

<u>Classroom Lessons</u> – I visit all grades to teach socialemotional skills such as feeling, communication, problem solving, diversity, respect etc.

Individual Counseling – I meet with students short – term to work through problems affecting them at school.

<u>Small Group Counseling</u> – I facilitate small groups for students who need a little extra support in a certain area.

<u>Consultation with Staff/Parents</u> – I am available to meet/talk with teachers and parents to help support students and provide resources and education about issues affecting children.

I am ONE part of the team that works to help your child succeed.

I like to get to know ALL students so they may feel connected and safe while they are with us.

We want your child to be successful. The first step is being at school every day and on time. If your child needs to be out for illness or other serious reasons, a written note from the parent/guardian or doctor is required. It should explain why your child was not at school in order for it to be excused. It also needs to be dated and signed by the guardian or medical professional. Faxes from doctor's offices are acceptable.

After 3 unexcused absences, parents/guardians will be required to attend a Catoosa Attendance Review Team Meeting. This team includes many community service agencies. Parents will be notified of these meetings in writing. The letter will be delivered to the home by both US mail & the Catoosa County Sheriff's Department.
