After Reading With Your Child



When You Think You're Done, You've Just Begun!

After enjoying a book with your child, (whether he reads to you, or you read to him) continue the experience by asking:

- * How did the story make you feel?
- * What did you like or dislike about the story?
- * Does the story remind you of any other story?
- * What were you wondering as you read?
- * Does this book make you think of anything else you've read?
- * What was your favorite part?
- * Were there any parts that surprised you?
- * What are you going to read next?
