Goals for Student Learning

District Goal:

- To improve the percentage of students scoring proficient (levels 3, 4) in grades 3 through 8.

School Goals:

- Increase the percentage of students who score in the Developing, Proficient, or Distinguished categories on Georgia Milestones mathematics in 4th and 5th grades by 5% during the 2017-18 school year.
- Increase percentage of students in 4th grade ELA who score in the Developing, Proficient, or Distinguished categories on Georgia Milestones by 5% during 2017-18 school year.
- Increase the percentage of students in 5th grade who score in the Developing, Proficient, or Distinguished categories on Georgia Milestones in Science by 5% during the 2017-18 school year.
- Increase the percentage of students in 5th grade who score in the Developing, Proficient, or Distinguished categories on Georgia Milestones in Social Studies by 5% during the 2017-18 school year.



TCE 3rd Grade Teachers

The 3rd Grade teachers will work with students and their families to support learning.

- Send home a weekly newsletter which will include spelling and vocabulary words.
- Provides monthly homework calendars for reading and math which include specific websites to support fact fluency and reading comprehension.
