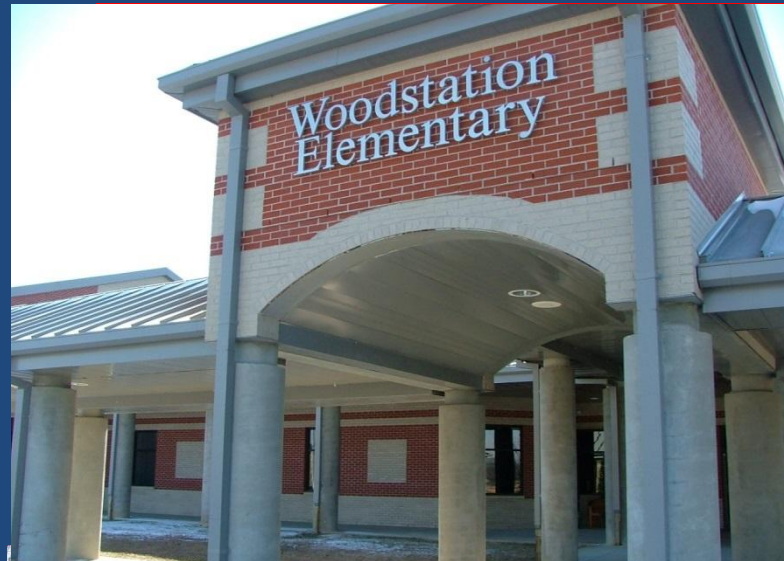

Science 92.77

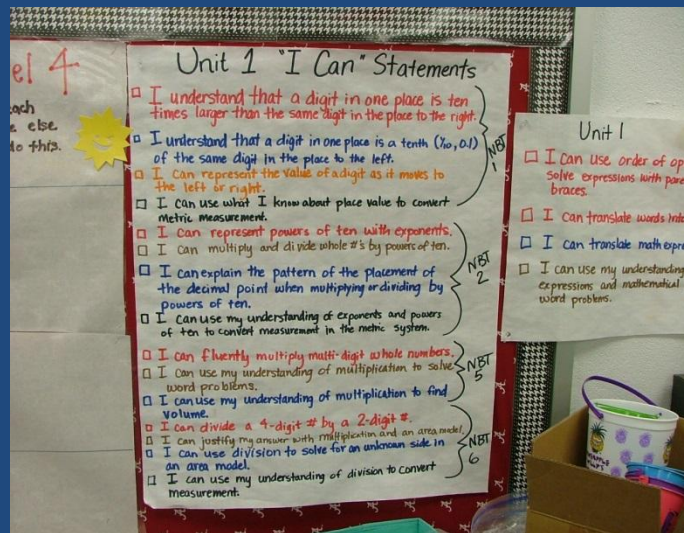

School Improvement Goal #1

All students will increase in Math

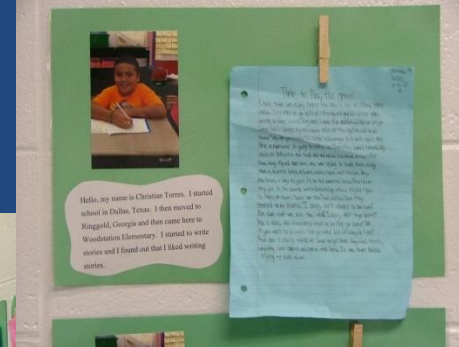
- Math Committee meets monthly to assess progress
- Workshop model: Mini Lesson, Work Time, Closing
- Using Thinking Maps- To prove answers and show work
- “I Can” Statements –Student self evaluation
- Max out on Math Facts- three benchmarks per year
- Using Star benchmarks to assess student progress
- 7 weeks prior to CRCT - After school Math tutoring
- Year long- school-wide increase in word problems

All students will be proficient in ELA/Reading

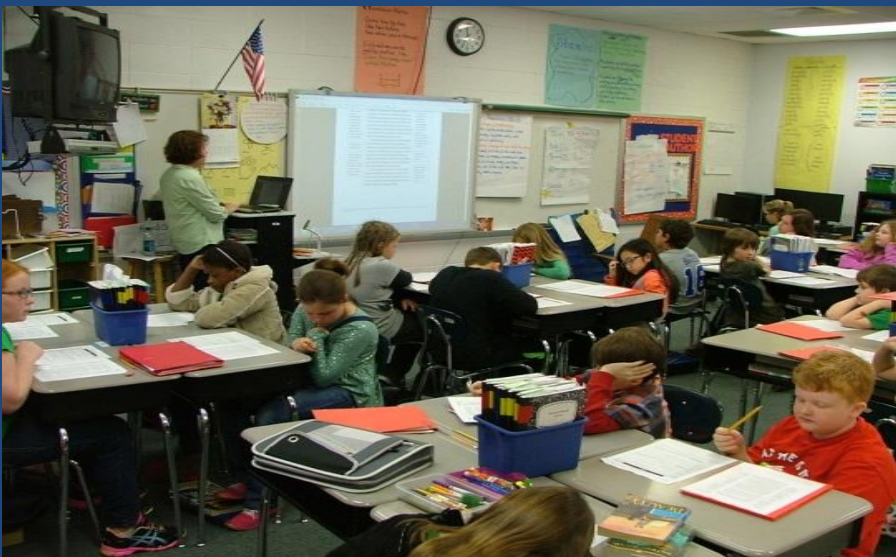
