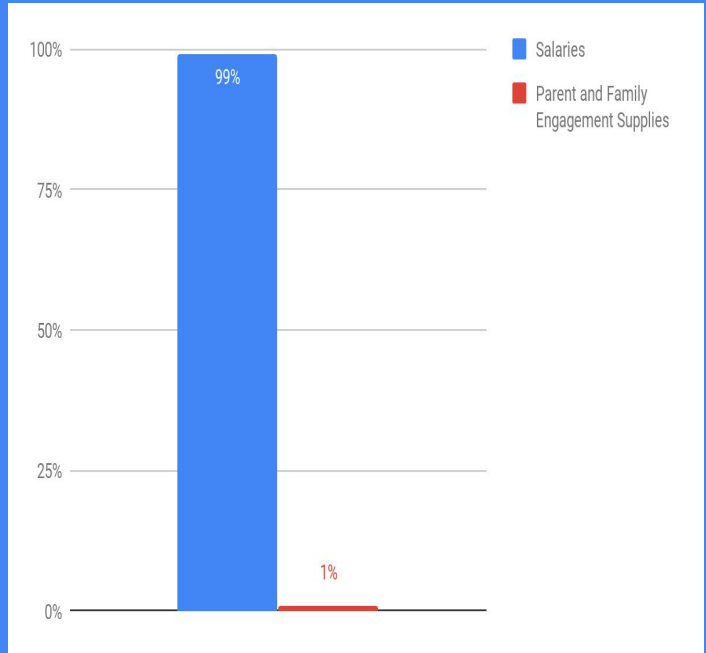
Title I Budget/Input

The district policy is also available for you to review today. Please leave us any comments or suggestions.

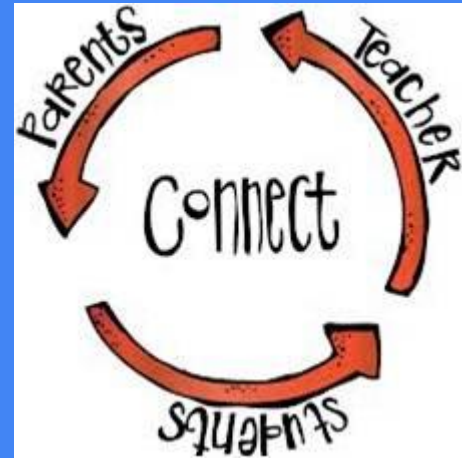

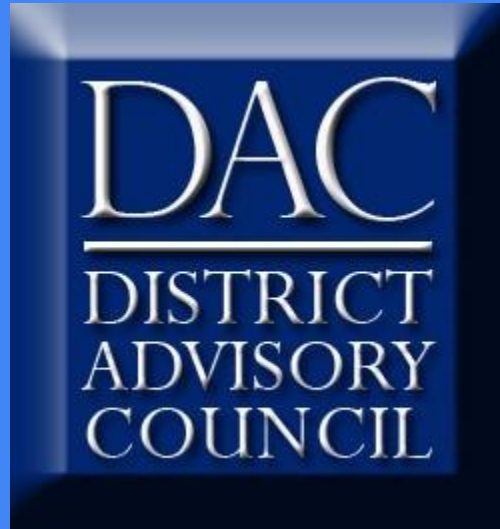
