- Refrain from giving gifts to students.
- Use adult restroom facilities when needed.
- Work with assigned student(s) in designated areas only.
- Leave any discipline of student(s) to the teacher or administrator.
- Let the teacher know if you are unable to show up at your scheduled time.

Maintaining Confidentiality

Volunteers must be diligent about honoring the confidentiality of each student. Breaching confidentiality can be hurtful to children, their families, and the staff.

- Do not share academic information about a student with anyone outside the school.
- Do not share information on how a student behaves with anyone outside the school
- Please do not repeat any comments heard at school to anyone
- Please avoid voicing concerns on social media or in public areas

In summary, when you have specific concerns, thoughts or feelings about anything you observe regarding teachers, students, or the school in general, talk to the teacher, principal, or the counselor only.
