  - participate in common planning to revise and create units, common assessments, and discuss student work.
- 2. Hold parent-teacher conferences at least twice a year during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement.** (Parent teacher conference held at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> 9week grading period, Open House at the beginning of the school year where the compact can be revisited as needed as well as at requested conferences)
- 3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress.** (Parent Portal, teacher reports sent periodically and at the end of each 4 ½ week in a 9 week grading period)
- 4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff.** (Parents can call, email or set up appointments through counselors to meet with teachers)
  - Provide parent school information notifications electronically
- 5. Communicate college, career and post-secondary options to students.** (Weekly advisement sessions held to transmit college, career and post-secondary available options, offer PSAT to all interested students, job shadowing opportunities through CTAE classes, students will update and utilize gacollege411 in preparation for post-secondary options)
