**Dear Trojan Fans,**

In an effort to insure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable experience at all Coffee High Athletic events, we are implementing new procedures that will be in place starting with the Houston County football game this Friday night, October 14<sup>th</sup>.

When entering an athletic event, students must have an **appropriate ticket** and their **identification badge** either from Coffee High, Wiregrass Regional College and Career Academy or G.W. Carver Freshman Campus. If a student in grades 9 through 12 does not have their student ID they must be accompanied by an adult willing to supervise them. Otherwise, the student will not be allowed to enter the event.

**All middle school and elementary school students attending an athletic event are required to be accompanied by an adult.** Parents or guardians of elementary school age students are reminded that their students are not to be dropped off at an athletic event without supervision. If an elementary student is found to be unsupervised, they will be reported to the appropriate authorities and parents or guardians will be contacted.

In addition to the above safety procedures, we would like to remind all of our Trojan fans about the following guidelines in place when participating in an athletic event.

- No one will be allowed to re-enter an event without purchasing another ticket. If an individual leaves the game before it is over, another ticket must be purchased.
- Smoking is not allowed at any event on school property, including Jardine Stadium.
- Alcohol or drugs are not allowed at any event on school property, including Jardine Stadium.
- Playing inside the stadium is not permitted. This includes the throwing of balls or other objects inside the stadium.
- Everyone should be seated in their assigned area, while the game is being played.

We appreciate all of our Trojan fans and your continued support of all the athletic programs within our district. We want *your* experience to be positive and safe for everyone!
