Academic Intramurals

This year our attention is directed toward test scores pertaining to the Criterion Referenced Competency Test and the 3rd and 5th Grade Georgia Writing Assessment. Our purpose for this event is to ensure that every child would participate on a team and study the Georgia Performance Standards from all core areas, except Social Studies. This event allows students to practice skills that are related to team sports, but also focus on the academics as well. A growing body of research has found that aerobic exercise increases blood flow to the brain, which helps students to think better and to retain information longer. The combining of low organized relays with concepts from Reading, English, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies will assist in our students mastering the Georgia Performance Standards in each subject area.


