## DRIVER'S EDUCATION

Learning to drive is a major milestone in your teen's life. It's important for young or inexperienced drivers to learn safe driving techniques. Joshua's Law requires **30 hours of classroom instruction** and **6 additional hours of drive time** with an instructor to receive a Class D license. Most insurance companies also give a reduction (approx. 10%) on insurance premiums upon successful completion.
