1st grade

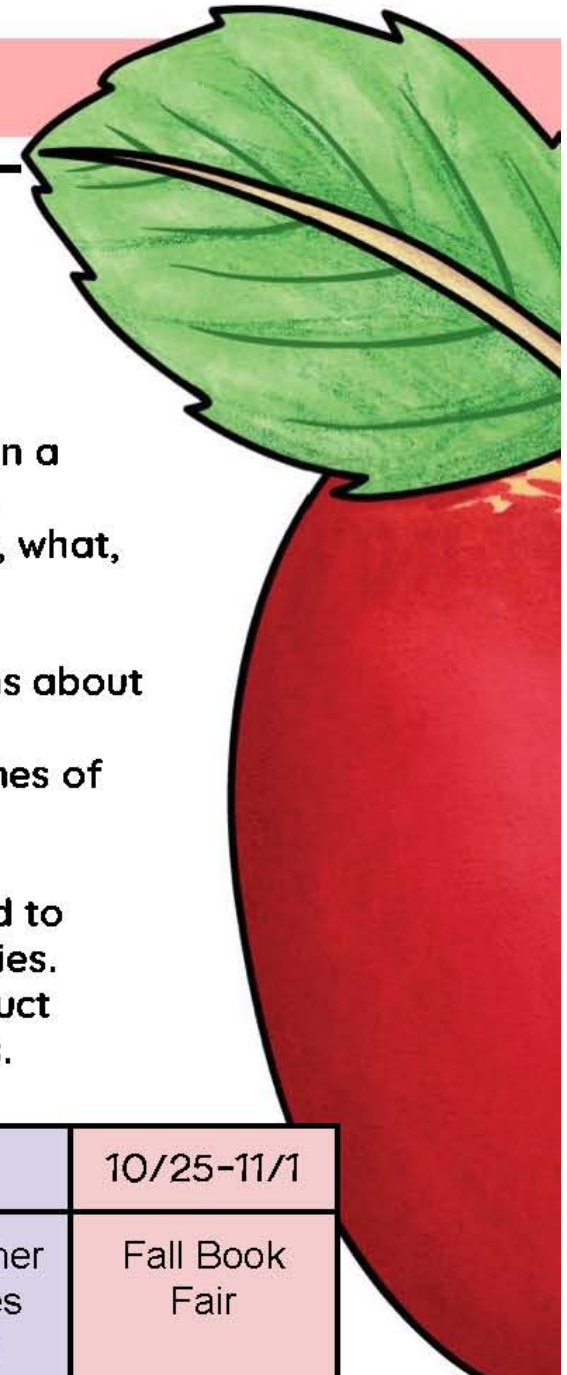
I can ask and answer questions about key details in a text.
