Students are expected to come to school prepared to learn every day. Each student should bring the necessary materials to class every day. This includes books, paper, pencils, and completed assignments. Below is a list of suggested materials that will be used throughout the year. Please take advantage of the Back to School store sales and stock up for the school year. All of these would be beneficial for your child, but the first five are essential.

- 4 Single-subject spiral notebooks (no perforated pages; MEAD Five-Star notebooks are very durable)
- Loose leaf notebook paper (4-100 sheet packs)
- Pencils 2-4 dozen for the year
- 1 inch 3-ring binder with pockets (no trapper keepers, or zipping binders)
- 5 Pocket folders with prongs
- A pair of inexpensive ear buds for electronic devices (no headphones, ear buds only)
- Washable markers (2 boxes of 10)
- Crayons (24ct.)
- 4 LARGE glue sticks
- Highlighters
- Student scissors
- 2 pack of Index Cards (3" x 5")
- Pencils 2-4 dozen for the year
- Small pencil sharpener (with a container for shavings)
- Colored pencils
- 4 Dry Erase Markers
- 3 Boxes of tissues, hand sanitizer
- Pencil pouch (NO BOXES)
- Page protectors
- Protractor
- Flash Drive
