- 1 inch 3-ring binder with pockets (no trapper keepers, or

- 5 **PLASTIC** Pocket folders with prongs (red-reading, green-math, yellow-science, blue-social studies, and orange-grammar)

- Crayons (24ct.)
- 4 **LARGE** glue sticks
