-Copy of student's certified Birth Certificate

-Social Security Card or Waiver

-Parent/Guardian Photo I.D.

-Current Mortgage statement & current utility bill OR Current lease & current utility bill. All

bills must be issued within the last 30 days.

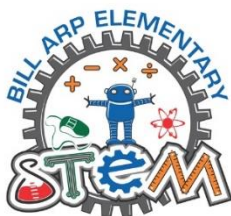
