TITLE I SCHOOL DESIGNATION PARENT NOTIFICATION

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965 requires that parents or guardians who have children attending a Title I school be notified of how well their school is preparing its students for college and/or a career, as well as the school's designation status under Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver.

Under the 2015 renewal of Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver, certain Title I schools continue to be designated as Reward, Priority, or Focus Schools. The Waiver allows the use of the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) as the comprehensive report card for all schools in Georgia, providing a score between 0-100 for each school—measuring how well the school is doing in preparing its students to be successful in college and/or a career.

Burnett Elementary's CCRPI for the 2015-2016 academic year was 62.4. You can find further information about our school score by going to the Georgia Department of Education website, <http://ccrpi.gadoe.org/2015/>.

I am very proud to tell you that Burnett Elementary School has not been given a school designation this year, which means we are a Title I school that is continuing to provide a quality education to all of our students.

Our CCRPI data shows that 32% of our students scored at the Developing Learner or above on the Georgia Milestone Assessment in English Language Arts. In addition, 35% of our students scored at the Developing Learner or above on the Georgia Milestone Assessment in Mathematics.

At Burnett Elementary School, we take pride in the teaching we provide for our children. Our teachers and staff members work very hard to meet the needs of all students to ensure they achieve at their highest potential.

An important part of Burnett Elementary's success is parent participation and support in developing activities to improve student achievement.
