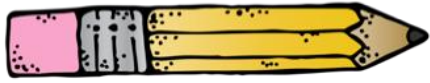

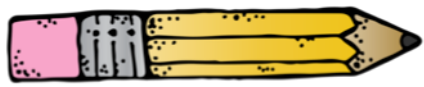
SECOND GRADE
