Honors Class Requirements

Students must meet the following requirements in order to be placed into a CHHS honors class:

- An "A" average in corresponding 8th grade course
- 75th percentile on the most recent norm-referenced test in the area most closely related to the class
- Accel. Algebra/Geometry = EOG 579 or above on math portion of the test
- Teacher or parent recommendation

End of Course (EOC) Tests your Freshman Year

- ✓ EOC classes: 9th Grade Literature and Algebra I and Biology
- ✓ Your EOC counts as 20% of your entire grade in the class.
- ✓ Your EOC scores may be used as a basis for placement into other classes.
- ✓ Your EOC is given in April - May and is cumulative over the entire year.

***Promoted to 11th Grade:** Student must earn 11 units/credits

***Promoted to 12th Grade:** Student must earn 18 units/credits

* Promotion and retention requirements are set by the State of Georgia Department of Education and the Douglas County School Board as listed on the date of this printing (3-15-15).

In four years, you will GRADUATE!

CHHS awards Special Recognitions based on the following academic criteria.

DCSS Board Scholar at Graduation

Earn maximum credits, take 1 extra core class, earn 2 units in same foreign language. **(3.5 GPA and no F's)**

CHHS Honor Graduate

Earn maximum credits, take 5 core classes during Senior Year, earn 2 units in same foreign language. **(3.75 GPA and no F's)**

Seals for your Diploma

Fine Arts Seal: 4 units / 2 from the same Fine Arts area

Academic Seal: 3 AP classes or 3 Move on When Ready (MOWR) Core Courses or 3 separate certificated CCI courses or any 3 combination

Foreign Language Seal: 3 units in the same Foreign Language
