Title I School Designation Parent Notification 08/18/2016

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

The Elementary and Secondary Act (ESEA) of 1965 requires that parents or guardians who have children attending a Title I school be notified of how well their school is preparing its students for college and/or career, as well as the school's designation status under Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver.

Under the 2015 renewal of Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver, certain Title I schools continue to be designated as Reward, Priority, or Focus Schools. The Waiver allows the use of the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) as the comprehensive report card for all schools in Georgia, providing a score between 0-100 for each school—measuring how well the school is doing in preparing its students to be successful in college and/or career.

Eastside Elementary School's CCRPI is 80.1. Please visit the Georgia Department of Education (GADOE) to review the schools CCRPI scores.

I am very proud to tell you that Eastside Elementary School has not been given a school designation this year, which means we are a Title I school that is continuing to provide a quality education to all of our students.

On the 2015-2016 Georgia Milestone Assessment, 3rd grade students on average scored 74% in Math and 76% in Science. However, we are committed to working hard to increase the 57% in English Language Arts and 63% Social Studies score.

Additionally, in 4th grade students scored 77% in Math and 76% in Science. Similar to 3rd grade, Eastside school personnel will work with students to improve the 53% English Language Arts score and 63% Social Studies score.

Last, 5th grade students average 77% in Math, 81% in Science and 83% in Social Studies. Special emphasis will be given to improve 5th grade English Language Arts score of 64%.

We take pride in the teaching we provide for our children at Eastside Elementary. Our teachers and staff members work very hard to meet the needs of all students to ensure they achieve at their highest potential.

An important part of Eastside Elementary School's success is parent participation and support in developing activities to improve student achievement. We hope that you will become involved in our school improvement work as we continue to monitor student achievement and set high expectations.
