- Provide resources, strategies, and activities to be shared at APTT meetings.
- Provide parents with a resource to take students from beginning/ending sounds, blends and digraphs.

AT HOME

Lithia Springs Elementary School parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' success in reading and math. Some of our key at-home activities will be:

- Utilize Eureka math resources and strategies when assisting students with homework
- Provide opportunities for my student to access the education websites; Starfall, MyOn and Odyssey
- Parents will attend APTT meetings and utilize the activities given with their child.
- Utilize reading resources and strategies when assisting students with homework
