21st Century Community in Schools Learning Center, Lithia Cohort: Cub Club at Lithia Springs Elementary

21st CCLC is to establish or expand after school programs that provide students with academic enrichment opportunities along with activities designed to complement the students' regular academic program.

The Program provides the following:

- Highly qualified Teachers from our school day
- Nutritional Snack
- Homework assistance/tutoring (between 30 - 40 minutes per day)
- Math, Reading/Writing, Social Studies, STEM, enrichment and remediation
- Structured Physical Education, Music, and Art
- Character Education
- Hands on Science club
- Transportation is provided within district

Cub Club is not a program that assists children with only homework. According to our guidelines our program offers enrichment, tutoring, and social interaction. Students must attend daily for the duration of the program. The hours are 3:15 PM-5:15 PM. Absences will require an excuse and excessive absences will require a program conference. A student may be removed from the program for excessive and consecutive absences.

The 21st CCLC grant is not a drop in program. Students must come every week for the entire year. The program has a limited number of slots and program is an invite program. Enrollment is based on identified academic needs by an intense rubric.

Parents will be required to attend 4 parent session by the end of the school year. There will be several surveys that will go home. We ask that you complete and return the surveys to school. More importantly, please communicate with the 21st CCLC Teacher if you have any concerns or celebrations about your student.
