

Dear Parents,

It has been brought to my attention by the 21st CCLC after school Impact program bus drivers that some students are not adhering to the bus conduct rules. In an effort to ensure that all students are safe during their bus ride home, please review these rules with your child. If your child violates any of these rules, he/she will be suspended from the bus for a time period as determined by the bus driver. Please sign (parent and student) and return to Mrs. Parkin tomorrow, December 4, 2014.

Bus Conduct Rules

School bus transportation is a privilege afforded pupils by the Board of Education. It is not a right. To protect the safety and well-being of all involved, pupils must adhere to established bus conduct rules. Bus transportation privilege may be revoked if the pupil does not observe bus conduct expectations.



1. Students must always conduct themselves in an orderly manner and obey all bus safety rules.
2. All students are under the jurisdiction of the driver while aboard each bus. Students should respect others at all times.
3. The driver is responsible for seating arrangements on each bus.
4. Students are to remain seated while bus is in motion.
5. Students must refrain from loud talking, horseplay, throwing objects on or from the bus, or doing anything that will detract from the driver's attention. Students must also refrain from fighting, threats of violence, or verbal conflicts.
6. Anyone damaging a bus will be responsible for restitution.
7. All parts of the body must be kept inside the bus at all times.
8. Chewing gum, eating, or drinking on the bus is not permitted.
9. It is the responsibility of the driver and each rider to help keep the bus clean.
10. The use of profanity on the bus will not be allowed.
11. Students will be picked up and delivered at their regular designated site each day. Written requests from the parent or guardian will be filed with Mrs. Parkin if it becomes necessary for a student to depart a bus other than at his/her regular stop. Mrs. Parkin will authorize the driver to make such a stop. Exceptions may be made if a safety hazard is involved.
12. Students must refrain from inappropriate display of affection.
13. Students are expected to abide by the Douglas County School System Student Conduct Behavior and Discipline Code.
14. Students shall not possess or use objects such as mirrors, lasers, flash cameras, or any other lights or reflective devices in a manner that might interfere with the school bus driver's operation of the school bus.

Please Note: This also includes the usage of any electronic devices during the operation of a school bus in a manner that might interfere with the school bus communications' equipment or the school bus driver's operation of the bus.
