Dual Enrollment Step-by-Step Process for Echols

- 1- READ CAREFULLY FAQ document that is attached to Echols County High School Counselor Website. Make sure you understand the DIFFERENCES in the rules and allowances now available to students grades 10-12!
- 2- If you plan to take an independent DE class at a college or online, you MUST have access to a computer/device and high-speed internet in order that you keep up with all assignments in the event of an emergency.
- 3- Students must meet DE requirements for entering the particular college he/she wants to attend. Most require testing requirements (Accuplacer or SAT/ACT). Wiregrass sometimes uses cumulative GPA or HOPE GPA. You can email the college or Mrs. Black to get the requirements. NO TEST WILL BE GIVEN AT ECHOLS this year. If you don't meet the testing requirements, you will need to make arrangements to take their admission test on your own at their campus before May 22.
- 4- Student must be maintaining at least an 85 cumulative high school GPA if they want to take college level core classes.
- 5- Students who want to take technical level DE classes (Intro to Healthcare, Cosmetology, Nursing-CNA, etc) on Echols Campus must be passing all their high school classes.
- 6- The student will fill out the application to the college they want to attend (some of the applications are FREE for DE so check the website first). If you have taken DE classes at this institution before, you do NOT need to fill out a new application.
- 7- The student will do the GAFUTURES application online along with the parent's part. (If you don't have a GAFUTURES account, DO NOT CREATE YOUR OWN ACCOUNT until you email Mrs. Black for instructions on creating an account).
- 8- Once you have been admitted to the college as a DE student, then you will let me know and we discuss the classes you are wanting to take and the time of day you want to take them.

9- Then, I will email the admissions counselor at the college and you, the student, on what has been decided for you to take.
