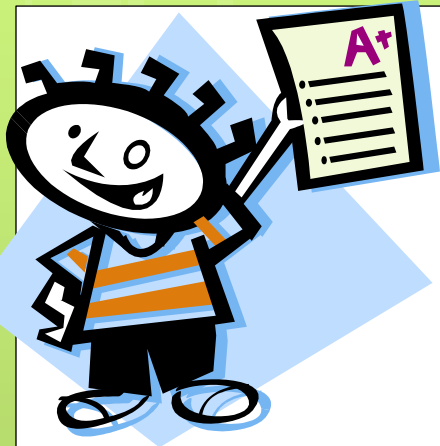

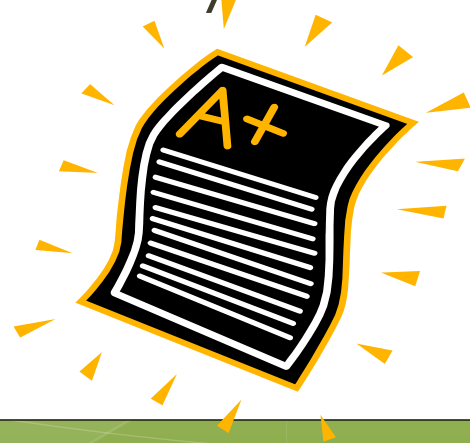

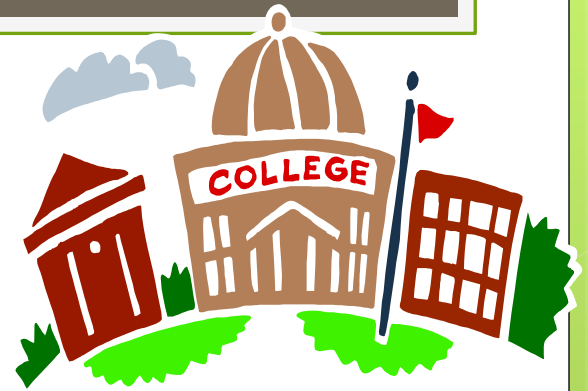

# Scholarships 101

- Create a resume of ALL accomplishments and activities throughout high school. (sample handout)
- Register on websites for searches that match your interests/skills. (links on Counselor webpage)
- Write good essays that answer the question provided. (sample) **GET THEM PROOFED BEFORE SENDING!**
- Work on applications before and after school in counseling office. **GET THEM PROOFED BEFORE SENDING!**
- Parents—set aside a couple of hours per week for scholarship work at home!



# Scholarships 101b

- NEVER PAY to get help with scholarships!
- Avoid loans if at all possible.
- Only borrow what you NEED when taking out student loans.
- Take advantage of Federal Work-Study Programs—could be a door of opportunity

# Community Service with a Smile



- Most scholarships ask for record of Community Service
- 300 hours for Georgia Dept. of Tourism and Volunteerism Graduation Cord (effective 2015)
- Can count as work experience when applying for a job
- Can open doors to jobs/careers
- Time logs available outside Counselor's door
- Off campus contracts-ask Mrs. Williams
- DEADLINE: Hours finalized by March 15<sup>th</sup>
