V. Curriculum/CTAE

- a. Presented to BOE
 - i. Business Pathway—changed graduation requirement; starting with students entering in the fall of 2017 computer course, will not be required; course still offered on voluntary basis in high school and offered in middle school for high school credit; accepted by BOE..
 - ii. Intro to Digital Tech—see above (offered at FCHS and FCMS on voluntary basis)
 - iii. Graduation Requirement— FCHS will still require 28 credits for graduation
- b. Capstone Project (140 Seniors complete)—counts towards CCRPI score; is a “requirement” for graduation but no state does not have any repercussions if not completed; consideration for the future be that student’s attending FCHS who do not complete Cap Stone not be allowed to participate in the Graduation Ceremony; this would start with discussion in SGT, Leadership and then would need “backing” of BOE; Cap Stone very beneficial to students to complete for their futures.
