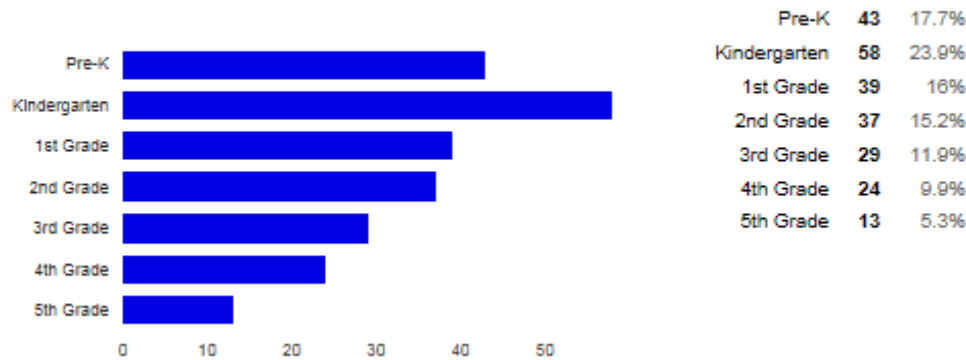
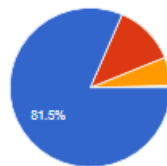

What grade is your child in this year?

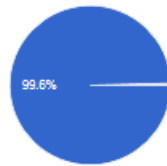


Do you feel welcomed at our school?



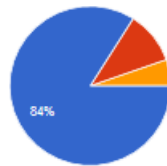

Are the school administrators, teachers, faculty, and staff available when you need them?



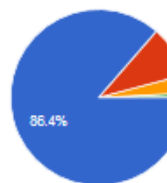

Do you feel that teachers in our school are interested and cooperative when you discuss your child's academic progress and/or other concerns?



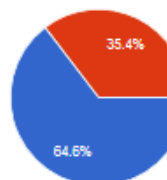

Does the school work with you to schedule parent meeting times to accommodate your work schedule?



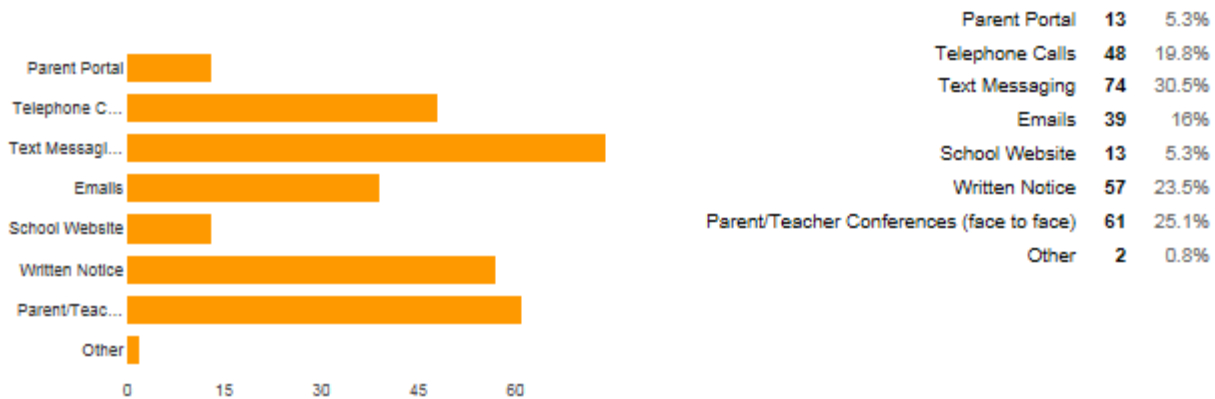

Do we provide opportunities for you to be involved in your child's academic achievement? (ex: Parent Conferences, PTO, Math/Literacy Nights, etc.)



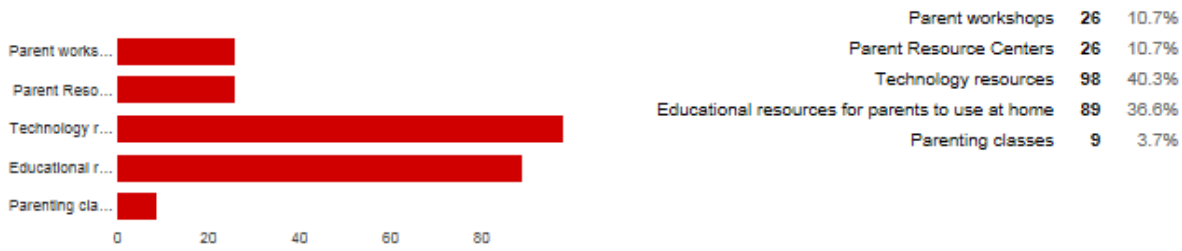
