Dear Parents and Students:

Well, it is done. Our school has officially split. While I must admit the split was tough for all of us, a smaller school provides our school numerous opportunities to re-think what we do for our students. In such times of change, it is appropriate to revisit our vision statement:

"Central Gwinnett High School will become a student-focused school committed to high student achievement that serves to cultivate and inspire the continuous improvement of the life-long learner both academically and in the global society."

Our Academies teach our students 21st Century skills which are necessary skills desired by professionals in both college and career tracks. Mastery of these skills will enable our students to prepare for college and be competitive in our global marketplace. In order to maximize our learning opportunities, we have moved to an A/B Block 8 period schedule. This means students will have the opportunity to take 8 classes each semester. Our goal is for our students to use the extra time to become pathway completers. Welcome CGHS parents and students!

We are pleased to announce that Central Gwinnett High School's orientation for the 2015-2016 school year is available through <u>www.MyPaymentsPlus.com</u>.

- If you already *have* a MyPaymentsPlus account and have completed the registration process, print your confirmation and present it at the welcome table to expedite your experience.
- If you *have not* already completed the process through MyPaymentsPlus report to any computer lab where teachers will assist you with the orientation process.
- Upon signing in to MyPaymentsPlus, you may view/print the necessary paperwork to complete your 2015-2016 school orientation. Once you acknowledge that you have read these documents, you may continue to the next screen. You will then be allowed to pay fees such as parking, lockers, and senior dues. Central also appreciates any contributions to the clinic or course departments in which your student may be enrolled.
- You may apply for free and reduced lunch by clicking on the link found at centralgwinnett.net website.
- You must print **your meal payments plus confirmation and receipt** and bring it to Orientation (receipt may also be shown on your smartphone).

Orientation Directions:

- Welcome Tables will be stationed at building entrances and in the cafeteria. You will
 receive your student's homeroom location at this time. <u>Be prepared to present your
 meal payments plus confirmation</u>. Those without confirmation will be directed to a
 nearby lab.
- 2. At your assigned homeroom location, be sure to complete the following items:
 - a. Receive your class schedule and packet of other information
 - b. Complete clinic card with parent signature
- 3. Report to the commons area/cafeteria for the following:
 - a. Clinic station for receiving medication/information
 - b. Cafeteria general information and free and reduced lunch forms
 - c. Bus schedules routes will be available in the commons and throughout the building
 - d. Parking fees are \$60.00
 - e. Schedule questions
 - f. Parent portal information/application turn in location

 - h. Lockers will be available in the commons and may be purchased for \$3.00

General School Information

School Start Time

Students are allowed into the building at the 6:45 A.M. The bell to begin first period will ring at 7:10. Students are released from classes at 2:10 P.M. Students must not be on campus before or after school hours unless supervised by a staff member.

Student Handbook

Central Gwinnett High School's Student Agenda/Handbook is a phone/tablet APP that can be downloaded at the beginning of school. The handbook can also be downloaded as a PDF at <u>centralgwinnett.net</u>. The CGHS student handbook includes important school information regarding our processes and procedures, general information, and discipline information. Students will also be receiving a Gwinnett County Public Schools Student/Parent handbook which will be reviewed with them during the first week of school.

Student Pickup and Drop-Off

Parents who drive their students to school should enter campus from Gwinnett Drive by the new gym and proceed to the four-story building for pickup/drop-off. Parents will then exit the campus onto Highway 29.

Parking

The cost for parking is \$60 for the school year and students must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance. An application must be completed and signed by the student and parent prior to purchasing a decal. Students must park in their designated area. Parking is limited and will be sold on a first come, first served basis.

Payment Options

Central accepts cash or an electronic check or debit/credit card transaction through the MypamentsPlus system. Assistance with the MypaymentsPlus payment system will be located in the media center during Open House.

Dress Code

Appropriate school attire is important. No student shall dress in such a way that distracts the learning process of other students. We appreciate parent and student cooperation in this matter. Students found in violation of the dress code will be to contact parents to bring appropriate attire or will be required to wear school provided clothing. Specific information regarding the dress code is available on the school website and in the student handbook.

Lunch Program

<u>Prepaid Meals</u>: Daily cost of meals is \$2.50. Breakfast is provided for all students at no charge. Side items are .40 cents each. Students may prepay for multiple meals. Students are not permitted to charge. <u>Refunds</u>: As the end of the year approaches, students should prepay only for the number of meals to be received. Amounts may be rolled over to the next school year for returning students. <u>Free/Reduced Lunch Forms</u>: You may apply for free and reduced lunch by clicking on the link found at centralgwinnett.net website. On-line Free/Reduced applications will be available for the 2015-2016 school year in mid-July.

Electronics

<u>Please be aware that students bring these items at their own risk.</u> Students who bring an electronic device (cell phone, mp3 player, camera, etc.) to school, device must turn them off and put them away during class. Students seen with these electronic items during instructional time, unless permitted by teacher for instructional purposes, will receive an administrative consequence. Students may not charge these items while on campus. Headphones may not be worn in the hallways.
