FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

(Q): FROM WHERE DO THE SCHOLARSHIPS COME?

(A): Throughout the year, several Universities, Colleges and professional organizations contact Norcross High School about various scholarships. The following table contains information on these University and company-sponsored scholarships. They are entered in the order that they are received; therefore, the most current scholarships are listed towards the latter portion of the table.

(Q): IS THIS AN EXHAUSTIVE LIST OF SCHOLARSHIPS?

(A): No. Additional scholarship opportunities are available through college admission and financial aid offices, as well as through company/employer websites. (Q): WHY DO THE EXPIRED SCHOLARSHIPS REMAIN ON THE SCHOLARSHIP TABLE?

(A): Junior students, and other underclassmen, are invited to review the scholarship table at the end of the year, in order that they are made aware of the scholarship opportunities that may be available to them in the future. They are able to review the eligibility criteria and may meet the eligibility requirements of their chosen scholarship (writing essays, gathering letters of recommendation, performing community service etc.) during the summer months. Many senior students miss scholarship opportunities because the scholarship deadlines often compete with college application deadlines, ACT/SAT test preparation and NHS homework assignments. Preparing the information in the summer allows students more time to better balance senior year responsibilities.

(Q): WHY, AT TIMES, DO THE APPLICATION AND DROP OFF DEADLINES DIFFER?

(A): At times, only a designated number of NHS students may compete for a scholarship. In fairness, nomination information is provided to all interested students. The NHS Scholarship Committee uses this information to select the students who will compete for the scholarship. This information must be returned by the *DROP OFF DEADLINE* in order that the Scholarship Committee select the recipient and then notify the recipient well before the *APPLICATION DEADLINE*. Also, scholarships often ask that applications be returned to the counselor; therefore, the *DROP OFF DEADLINE* is also created in respect to delivery time.
