Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965 requires that parents or guardians who have children attending a Title I school be notified of how well their school is preparing its students for college and/or a career, as well as the school's designation status under Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver.

Under Georgia's ESEA Flexibility Waiver, certain Title I schools are designated as Reward, Priority, Focus, or Alert schools. The Waiver also allows the use of the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI), which serves as a comprehensive report card for all schools in Georgia. The CCRPI provides a score between 0-100 for each school, and that score measures how well the school is doing in preparing its students to be successful in college and/or a career.

I am very proud to tell you that **Wilbanks Middle School** has not been given a school designation this year, which means we are continuing to provide a quality education to all of our students.

We are exceptionally proud of our student performance in the areas of Reading and English Language Arts on the 2014 CRCT. In reading 95% of our students met the standard and 44% exceeded the standard. In ELA 91% of our students met the standards with 38% exceeding the standard.

At **Wilbanks Middle School**, we take pride in the teaching we provide for our children. Our teachers and staff members work very hard to meet the needs of all students to ensure they achieve at their highest potential.

An important part of **Wilbanks Middle School's** success is parent participation and support in developing activities to improve student achievement.
