Northside Parents,

You were asked to complete the 2015 Houston County Parent Satisfaction Survey in March. This survey allowed us to gather your input about the Title 1 program here at Northside High school. Provided below are responses to some of the items from the survey.

Question: I am informed about the Title I program at my student's school and received the Title I Parent handbook containing the Parent Involvement Plan and School-Parent Compact.

Answer: The NHS Title I Handbook is given to every parent at the beginning of the year during Open House. These documents are also made available on our school website, in both front offices, and in the Parent Resource Room.

Question: The information provided in the Title I Parent Involvement Plan and School – Parent Compact is detailed and easy to understand.

Answer: We strive to ensure that all of our documents are written and presented in such a way that they are easily understood and useful for stakeholders.

Question: I have been given opportunities to provide input in the decision making process regarding the Parent Involvement Plan, Compact, Schoolwide Plan, and budget at my student's school and district.

Answer: Each spring, usually during Evening Advisement, we provide a shared decision making opportunity for all stakeholders. We provide an overview of the Title I documents and we encourage our parents to make comments and suggestions about the information presented to them. These comments and suggestions are used to create the parent documents for the next school year. Parents are also encouraged to call the Parent Involvement Coordinator throughout the year if they have comments or concerns that they want to share.

Question: I am aware that I can participate in shared decision making opportunities through parent input meetings, the Parent Action Team, and School Council.

Answer: We make every effort to keep our parents well informed about all meetings and parent opportunities. We advertise events through the school newspaper, documents handed out during OE, call outs, emails, the electronic marquee, the school website, and a monthly school calendar.

Question: The school's Parent Involvement Coordinator assists families, supports parent activities, and is available for questions or concerns from parents.

Answer: The Parent Involvement Coordinator at Northside High School is Nyquell Terry. She coordinates parent activities and volunteer opportunities. She is available to assist parents on a daily basis. Her office is located in the main office at Tabor.

Question: I am aware of the Parent Resource/Information Center in my child's school.

Answer: The Parent Resource Center is located off the lobby in the Tabor building. The resource room is open daily from 7:30 – 3:30. The room is stocked with a variety of print materials related to academics, behavior and parenting. Parents are taken on a tour of the school at the beginning of the school year during Open House and Freshman Night. The Parent Resource room is a part of that tour. Freshman Parent/Teacher Conferences are also held in the Parent Resource Room.
