School Responsibilities

Tucker Elementary School will work closely with students and their families to support success in reading. Some of the key elements used this process are:

Initiating contact in the month of August with every TES parent or guardian to build a positive, proactive relationship. (Habit #1)

Sending home progress reports to every TES parent or guardian 4 times per year. (Habit #2)

Providing four academic workshops that are each offered at 3 different times each date: 7:45-8:15AM; 12:15-12:45PM, 5:15-5:45PM to accommodate our family's needs/schedules. (Habit #6)

At Home

Tucker Elementary School parents can help support student success by:

- **Helping teachers teach your child to take care of and return the bag of books daily. (Habit #1)**
- **Scheduling a conference in September to discuss the first 9 weeks' progress report. (Habit #1)**
- **Attending all teacher requested conferences and returning all teacher phone calls in a timely manner. (Habit #3)**
- **Attending family workshops offered September 8, November 7, January 23, and March 6. (Habit #6)**
- **Using tools from workshops to advance your child's reading level. (Habit #2)**

Tucker Student Leaders

Tucker Elementary School students can succeed at home and school by:

- “Being proactive” (Habit #1) Taking care of and bringing back the bag of books daily.
- “Beginning with the end in mind (Habit # 2) - Setting and working toward independent reading growth goals.
- “Synergizing” (Habits #6) – Working collaboratively with their teachers and parents/guardians to grow one or more reading bands this school year.

What is a School-Parent Compact?

A school-parent compact is an agreement that explains how parents, teachers, and students will work together to make sure all students reach grade-level standards.

Jointly Developed

This agreement was jointly developed by stakeholders and is reviewed/revised annually based on feedback from all stakeholders. Compacts will be discussed during parent-teacher conferences.
