The School Will...

- Initiate contact in the month of September with every TES parent to build a positive, proactive relationship.
- Send home a progress report at least three times per year that includes past academic level and current academic level for reading, spelling inventory, and math power level gaps.
- Provide an appropriate leveled bag of books for each student for nightly reading.
- Provide an HCLI reading workshop with individual student data. Workshop will be offered at different times to accommodate our family's needs and schedules.
- Provide a spelling Word Work workshop that is offered at different times to accommodate our family's needs and schedules.
- Provide a monthly grade level math newsletter with current unit level strategies.

Home Will...

- Schedule a conference in September to discuss student progress and academic metrics.
- Review and respond to all teacher correspondence including academic reports, phone calls. Attend all teacher requested conferences.
- Read nightly from the bag of books provided to advance your child's reading level.
- Attend HCLI reading workshop and talk to student about reading.
- Attend Word Work workshop and discuss strategies with student.
- Review monthly math newsletter with student and discuss strategies with student.

Tucker Student Leaders Will...

- Deliver all school correspondence to parents in a timely fashion.
- Review progress report at home with parents.
- Read from the bag of books each night and return the bag to school each day.
- Remind parents about school workshop dates.
- Review monthly math newsletter and discuss strategies with parents.

What is a School-Parent Compact?

A school-parent compact is an agreement that explains how parents, teachers, and students will work together to make sure all students reach grade-level standards.

Jointly Developed

This agreement was jointly developed by stakeholders and is reviewed/revised annually based on feedback from all stakeholders. Compacts will be discussed during parent-teacher conferences.
