Eligible Students & Coursework

- **Eligible Students:**

- All students attending public or private high schools in Georgia or a home study program operated in accordance with O.C.G.A. 20-2-690(c)
- Must be approved by the high school
- 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grades (Summer after graduation nor summer before 9th grade is covered by MOWR)
- No residency or citizenship requirement
- Meet admissions requirements at postsecondary institution
- Must not have already received a high school diploma

- **Eligible Coursework:**

- Students receive both secondary and postsecondary credit
- Academic and/or Technical courses
- Courses can be taught on the high school, college campuses, Career Academies or online
- **TRANSFERABLE Core/academic course to USG colleges**
 - List of 27 courses (ENGL1101, MATH1111, PSYC1101, etc.)

What does MOWR Cover?

- Students apply EACH term on GaFutures.org (fall, spring & summer)
 - Note- summer term after HS graduation is not covered by MOWR
- MOWR covers full tuition, fees and books!
- The **MOWR** Tuition award amount is:
 - Amount equal to the current academic year Standard Tuition amount
 - Up to a maximum of 15 hours per term
- Students enrolled at two or more colleges during a single term:
 - Student can receive Tuition payment at each Eligible school
- Mandatory fees are fully covered (course-related fees or supplies may apply)
- The cost of textbooks



Why is Dual Enrollment Important?

- Students benefit in various ways:
- Expands course offerings
- College credit at no charge to high school students
- Creates pipeline of students & workers
- Helps improve high school graduation rate
- Boosts students' confidence & skill level
- Exposes students to college curriculum while in high school
