

Dixie Crow Chapter of the Association of Old Crows \$500 High School Senior Scholarship

This scholarship is to support students seeking degrees potentially leading to a career in the Electronic Warfare profession, whether ultimately here at Robins Air Force Base, or elsewhere.

Preference will go to Electrical/Electronic/Computer Engineering first, then to other engineering fields (mechanical, industrial, etc) with potential application to aircraft avionics systems. Other computer, mathematics and hard sciences degrees (such as physics as opposed to biology) may be considered if there are no candidates seeking the previously stated degrees. Other degree programs are not acceptable. If there are no applicants meeting this requirement, no scholarship will be awarded that year. There is no long term obligation to remain in that program or pursue employment in that field, but at the time of award applicants must be applying for or accepted in an applicable degree program.

This scholarship is intended for students demonstrating some financial need. Seniors with tuition and course material already fully funded by other scholarships should not be considered.

Selection will be made by a person or group designated by each school. The first selection criteria is the degree chosen as indicated above. From those, selection is to be made based on GPA, ACT/SAT scores, financial need, and the response in the additional information section above. Weighting of each factor is left to the discretion of the selection group.

Application for or acceptance of this scholarship does not affect eligibility for the renewable Dixie Crow Scholarships available at Georgia Tech, Mercer, Macon State, and Fort Valley State. Those scholarships are administered entirely by those schools themselves.

The scholarship is to be presented annually at each school's senior awards ceremony. The school will designate who to turn the application in to and what the deadline for application is. They must be received in time to make a selection and be approved before the awards ceremony.

The Dixie Crows shall be notified of the selection before announcement to the recipient. The Dixie Crows reserve the right to veto a selection not meeting the intent of the above stated requirement for the degree program.
