You are applying for a \$1,000.00 educational scholarship funded by the Ebony Drivers of Middle Georgia. If selected the scholarship check will be remitted timely to the designated college or vocational institution. The purpose of the scholarship is to defray the college cost of a graduating senior from one of the four Houston County high schools. The applicant must graduate from high school with a minimum GPA of 2.5 with verification from high school counselor, be a solid citizen, submit a one page (minimum) essay discussing how the scholarship will be used; planned educational pursuit, the name of the university or college, and a letter of reference/recommendation from a high school faculty member; or an adult neighbor/friend, or an employer, or a church official (i.e., Minister, Deacon, Pastor). Complete application package must be received by 30 June 2018.

RULES

1. Applicants must currently attend a secondary school and have permanent residence in Houston County at the time of graduation.
2. Scholarship is open to all Houston County High Schools Students meeting requirements.
3. Scholarship recipients must enroll fulltime (defined by the institution) at an accredited institution
4. Applicants can pursue any major field of studies offered by the accredited institution.

PROCESS

1. Applicant must submit 1 original and two copies of the completed application. Each application must include at least one recommendation, an essay, GPA verification form (original plus two copies).
2. Applicants are responsible for verifying that the EDMG review board has received all application materials.
3. After review, the EDMG review board will notify the successful scholarship applicant and the designated educational institution.
4. Upon proof of registration at the designated educational institution a check will be issued to that school. The check may be used for the costs that can be charged directly to the institution attended, such as tuition, room and board, books, lessons, and other educational expenses.
