SCHOLARSHIPS FOR UNDERGRADUATE SCHOOL

Clifton-Whitehead Scholarship Fund

For graduates of an accredited high school in Bibb, Houston, Crawford, Twiggs, Jones, Peach, or Monroe Counties, who are pursuing a Bachelor's degree. A preference will be given to those students in Bibb County.

Additional requirements

- 1) A short essay response listing all honors and awards you have received in high school and college, a description of your career goals, and any special personal or family circumstances affecting your need for financial assistance.
- 2) One recommendation from your academic dean, advisor, counselor, or teacher.

Education Together Scholarship Fund

For graduating seniors of public or private high school or homeschooled students in Bibb, Crawford, Houston, Jones, Monroe, Peach and Twiggs counties who are accepted and plan to attend colleges, universities and technical colleges in Middle Georgia.

Additional requirements

- 1) One recommendation.

P. Allen Golson Scholarship Fund

For a student attending the University of Alabama who graduated from a public or private high school in one of the following central Georgia counties: Monroe, Bibb, Peach, Houston, Jones, Lamar, Baldwin or Spalding County.

Additional requirements

- 1) A short essay response about choosing to attend the University of Alabama.



Scholarships for which Houston County students may be eligible:

The Billy and Bobby Stevens Scholarship Fund

For the pursuit of an undergraduate degree for graduates of accredited high schools in the following counties: Bibb, Houston, Crawford, Twiggs, Jones, Peach, or Monroe Counties.

Additional requirements

1) One recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or mentor that describes the applicant's character, personality, and likelihood of success in college.

The Shield Club Scholarship Fund

For current employees of the Bibb County Sheriff's Department or the Macon-Bibb County Fire Department, or their spouse or children.

Additional requirements

1) The contact information (Title, Name, Phone number, Email) of your respective sheriff, police chief or fire chief.

2) One recommendation from your school principal, guidance counselor, or teacher/professor.

Career Women's Network Scholarship Fund

For a non-traditional female student that is at least 25 years of age, working towards a Bachelor's degree.

Additional requirements

1) Applicants may be interviewed as part of the application process.

2) A short essay response describing your educational goals, career plans and commitment to community service.

Joyce Brown Memorial Scholarship Fund

For nursing students (not pre-nursing students). Preference will be given to applicants who are working or plan to work at Navicent Health.

Additional requirements

1) Two recommendations from a teacher, school personnel or other adult who can attest to your dedication to education and to the nursing profession.

2) A short essay response describing your career plans and why you aspire to be a nurse.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR BALLET SCHOOL

Gladys Lasky Scholarship Fund

For ballet students to participate in classical ballet instruction or summer intensives.

Additional requirements

1) A series of short essay response

2) One recommendation letter from your current or most recent ballet instructor.

3) A copy of the first page of my parent/guardian's most recent Form 1040 OR a written explanation of your financial need.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR GRADUATE SCHOOL

John and Nancy Nations Scholarship Fund

For students from Georgia to attend a United Methodist seminary or Asbury Theological Seminary with the intent of becoming a United Methodist minister.

Additional requirements

1) A short essay response describing what you want to do with your seminary degree.

The G. Michael Shoffner M.D. Scholarship Fund

For a non-traditional medical school student that is at least 25 years of age, working towards a M.D or D.O degree in the state of Georgia.

Additional requirements

1) Applicants may be interviewed as part of the application process.
